IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. All servicing should be performed by qualified service personnel.
- 2. Unit to be installed only as per configuration described in this instruction manual.
- 3. All unused wires must be capped to prevent shorting.
- 4. Indoor use only.
- 5. Do not mount near any heat source.
- 6. Equipment should be mounted in locations where it will not readily be subjected to tampering by unauthorized personnel.
- 7. The use of accessory equipment not recommended by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
- 8. Do not use this unit for other than its intended use.

Installation Instructions

- 1. Turn off power supply.
- 2. Remove back plate from unit.
- 3. For conduit entry, attach a conduit connector to junction box and insert a flexible conduit into conduit connector leaving 6 inches of wire inside the junction box. Secure flexible conduit to junction box. (see fig. 2)
- 4. For pendant mount, secure pipe to junction box and leave 6 inches of wire inside junction box. (see fig. 2)
- 5. Feed AC or DC supply leads through large hole in back plate.
- 6. Install back plate to junction box following proper orientation. (see fig. 1 & 3)
- Electrical connections: (see fig. 4) For AC remote 120 to 277VAC: connect white lead to neutral and purple lead to AC supply.
- For DC remote 6 to 24VDC: connect red to positive and blue to negative.
- Position AC or DC supply wire connections in designated area in the housing and snap housing to back plate. (see fig. 4)
- 9. Turn on power supply.

Important: Install product no higher than the maximum mounting height of 12 feet from the floor. CAUTION: DO NOT LOOK DIRECTLY INTO ILLUMINATED
