### IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed including the following:

### READ AND FOLLOW ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. All servicing should be performed by qualified service personnel.
2. All unused wires must be insulated to prevent shorting.
3. Do not use outdoors.
4. Do not let power supply cords touch hot surfaces.
5. Do not mount near gas or electric heaters.
6. Equipment should be mounted in locations and at heights where it will not readily be subjected to tampering by unauthorized personnel.
7. The use of accessory equipment not recommended by the manufacturer may cause an unsafe condition.
8. Do not use this equipment for other than its intended use.
9. Units to be installed only as per configuration described in this instruction manual.

### SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

#### Installation instructions (Figure 1)


Note: Lamp head(s) may already be attached to the canopy.

1. Determine the final position for the lamp head(s).
2. Insert the square surface from the swivel into the square hole on the canopy. Secure the lamp head in place with the lock washer and nut provided.
3. Adjust the head(s) into their final position.
4. If applicable: install the spider plate to the junction box using the junction box screws.
5. Make the proper connections. The fixture is designed for 6, 12 or 24 VDC (see the lamp voltage indicated on the inside surface of the canopy). Connect the lamp wires to the DC supply wires.
6. Use the canopy screws to install the canopy.

#### Adjust the lamp head (Figure 2):

- Rotation: loosen the rotation screw, turn lamp head to desired location. Tighten rotation screw to lock position.  
-Note: The lamp head can be rotated 150° to either side.
- Tilting: loosen tilt screw, hold the lamp head and tilt it up or down. Tighten tilt screw to lock position


